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Instructions for Upper Endoscopy (EGD)

1. **Medication:** Please notify us if you are on the following medications: **Plavix, Aggrenox, Coumadin, Warfarin, Pradaxa, Effient or Xarelto.** You may need to stop these medications 5 days prior to your procedure. **Lovenox** or **Fragmin** should not be used the day of the procedure. If you are Diabetic, please consult your primary care physician regarding your medication and diet. **If you take antibiotics prior to seeing your dentist please notify your physician.** You may continue to take all other medications. Please call our office with any questions you may have.
2. **Diet:** Nothing to eat or drink after midnight.
3. **Additional Instructions:** Please remove all jewelry prior to the procedure.
4. **Transportation:** **Taxicabs are not acceptable. You must have someone you know drive you home. From the time you arrive at our facility until the time you leave may require 2 to 3 hours.**
